

**D6082 High Temperature Foam Surveillance Panel Telecon

The meeting was called to order at 2:05 pm by Dennis Gaal.

Meeting agenda and presentation is in Attachment 1.

ASTM anti-trust statement and electronic recording policy were reviewed.

Agenda was reviewed and approved by unanimous agreement.

The minutes from the last SP meeting (8-7-2018) had been posted on the TMC website and were reviewed. A motion to accept the minutes as posted was made by Shawn Dubecky with a second by Mike Birke. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

The limits for FOAMB18 had been set based on 18 results at the prior SP meeting in 2018. For many prior periods, the oil performance has been mild compared to this initial target, so it has been desired to review the additional results generated on FOAMB18 to determine final limits.

John Loop discussed the results for FOAMB18 in Attachment 2 as there are now 131 results on the reference oil. Including all the results, the mean value for FOAMB18 decreased from 54 to 48.8 mL, in line with the outcome from many past periods, while the standard deviation also decreased. As the test results are reported in units of 10 mL, the results have been consistently between 40 and 60 mL with only one low result and only three results at 70 mL.

Based on the analysis of the full data set, there were two proposed options for the new limits – change the target value from 54 mL to 48.8 mL and either retain the current limits of 40 to 70 mL or revise the limits to 40 to 60 mL given the lower mean result and smaller standard deviation. After some discussion on the rarity of having a 70 mL result, a motion to change the target value to 48.8 mL and set the limits to 40 to 60 mL was made by Joe Franklin and seconded by Mike Birke. The motion passed unanimously.

There was no other Old Business.

New Business

As Matt Schlaff had stepped down as SP chair, Karina Gil had volunteered to assume the chair for the D6082 SP. A motion to accept Karina as the new SP chair was made by Mike Birke with a second by Joe Franklin. The motion carried unanimously.

There was no additional New Business.

A motion to adjourn was made by Shawn Dubecky with unanimous consent as the meeting ended at 2:25 pm.
