All of the new AEM -1 data batches 13 and 14 were submitted; however no statistics have been performed yet. Doyle Boese of Infineum volunteered/was appointed to review the data. Once the data has been reviewed, the statistics will be sent out to the group, and another teleconference will be held. Becky Grinfield noted a request from GM that since the LDEOC test is used in specifications other than ISLAC GF-5 and API SN, that some clarification be added to the report form to specify the limits are the SN/GF-5. Mike McMillan asked why the specification limits were on the report in the first place, Mike Kasimirsky agreed that it was a good question. A motion was put forth by Mike Birke to remove the specification limits from the LDEOC report form. There was unanimous consent, so TMC will get to work amending the form and the usual beta testing will follow. Jason Bowden asked about whether or not OHT should ship out the new AEM-1 and ACM material, even though it has not been formerly approved. The group decided that he should, and if any problems arise the labs will ship the material back.
