

LDEOC/EOEC SURVEILLANCE PANEL MINUTES

A LDEOC/EOEC conference call was held on Tuesday, 5-3-16, at 1 pm Central Standard Time. The following members were on the call:

Data from the donated 1006-2 runs were reviewed. The vast majority of the data was within the current acceptance limits. Mike Kasimirsky noted 1006-2 is also used in other tests; however it is identified as service fluid 105, where it has been used as a direct replacement for 1006-1 with no issues. Mike Lopez made a motion to start running fluid 1006-2 using the current limits for both EOEC and LDEOC. The data will be re-examined after 30 points *per elastomer* have been generated. A surveillance panel meeting will be held at that time to determine a path forward. There was a second to the motion, and no opposition, so the motion carried. There are approximately 2562 gallons of 1006-2 on hand, however since it is used for other tests, including the Sequence 5G tests, as noted by Mike McMillan, it is difficult to predict how long the supply will last. An estimate of 18 months was made. Since the performance of Oil 1006 is used as part of the seals limits for the HD specifications, Dennis Gaal will approach the heavy duty class panel for their new reference oil recommendations.
