13:33cst BATCH CODE 7 FILTER MEDIA

Panel chairman Becky Grinfield (Southwest Research) called the teleconference to order at 13:35cst. The participant list is shown as attachment 1. The purpose of the meeting was to determine a means for collecting data on the new batch code 7 (BC7) filter media.

Becky asked Scott Parke (TMC) to suggest a method for producing data. Scott said that he'd prefer that ideas come from the panel but that if they had none he felt that running additional runs in conjunction with regularly scheduled runs seems to have worked well in the past.

Jason Bowden (OHT) was asked what the alternatives were if the panel did not move to the new batch of filter media. He replied that the BC7 media is really the only available material. The panel asked Jason if OHT could donate the filter samples necessary to gather introduction data. He agreed to supply each of the three active labs with 100 samples (10 for EOFT, 10 for each oil/treat level combination, and 10 spare).

13:49cst OIL 77 REBLEND AVAILABLE

Scott Parke noted that the supply of oil 77 is nearing depletion. TMC has secured a reblend (77-1) which will probably need to be introduced sometime in the next six months or so.
