As approved by Email ballot, the Gelation Index (GI) report packet has been updated and approved by the ASTM Data Communications Committee. The revised forms have a new, standardized bench test heading and ALTCODE and LABOCODE field lengths have been expanded. Also, the Gelation Index (GELIND) data type has been changed to type "A" (alpha-numeric) which allows for a "<" (less-than) symbol in the result for non-gelling oil test results. Please note that TMC calibrations will still require a numeric value to be reported, less-than symbols are not acceptable for TMC calibration results.

The revised GI report packet version 20020204 will replace the current version 19970128 effective April 15, 2002. Version 20020204 report forms (in PDF format), data dictionary, repeating fields specification and summary of changes (in text format) are available from the TMC's website:
