For test hours prior to 360, the TGA soot values for the 1R test are typically very low. Consequently, the surveillance panel removed the requirement to report any measurements prior to 360 hours after completion of matrix testing. This revision to the 1R report package removes from form 7 the fields for reporting these values. It also corrects a typographical error that had the fields for QI and average fuel pressure and exhaust backpressure reversed. This report package is posted on the TMC web site as 1R report package version 20030409. This report package will be in effect for tests reported to the TMC on or after May 15, 2003.
