The purpose of the conference was to continue the discussion as to how to move forward with 1P liners. The group was charged with determining what defect level may be tolerable for a test to be run. After discussion, general consensus was for the CAT sponsored test to be run on a liner in the 96 - 99 defect count range with porosity at or below 9%. Upon completion of the test, the panel will reconvene to determine if running industry coordinated references would be the logical next step.

The question was raised as to in-spec new hardware. General consensus was that this hardware is OK to use upon receipt.

CAT noted that 25 sets of oil rings have been sent (16 to Texas, 9 to Ohio). There should be another 24 available in mid-December.

The panel will meet again after the completion of the 1P test mentioned above.
