**Intertek Reference Update:**

- Three tests ran at Lab G were ran with results within alarm limits on 833-1 oil
- Lab G can run two more tests before referencing

**832-1 Update:**

- Two barrels of 832-1 were re-mixed (not re-blended) by the supplier
- Lab G will run one test on the re-mixed 832-1 with batch A filter to determine if re-mixing the oil brings aeration results back to historical levels

**Batch B Filter Introduction:**

- Batch A Filter Inventory
  - Lab A x4
  - Lab G x4
  - Lab B x16
  - TEI x10
- The process for introducing batch B filters was discussed at length

- Batch A filters need to be retained for EOAT backwards compatibility testing
- Batch B filter reference testing will need to be completed by the labs and the SP will review results and operational data
- No timeline determined
