New ISM Crossheads and Injector Screws

Lubrizol is currently offline until September, but have about two month's worth of hardware. Intertek indicated two more kits worth.

Zack Bishop indicated that there isn't a great deal of hardware available to re-distribute. Marnix Torreman indicated that ChevronOronite's calibration is up in a month or so.

The discussion moved on to how to get data on the new parts, hopefully through coordinated reference tests. Re-manufactured ISB Engine
