Two questions for this call:

1. Do we allow adjustments to the reference period for the remaining calibrated stand(s)?
2. Do we need coordinated references for the new batch of injector adjusting screws? If so, when?

One last quick item would be get a “straw-man” poll on whether to pursue the newer LTMS for the ISM which would allow labs to run references without lining up coordinated references.

Some labs have old hardware available at least 1 lab is out.

Can we redistribute old hardware? Labs with old hardware are willing to help the lab without hardware

Is there potential for increased future demand?

Most labs are out of calibration with no real timeframe for when they will calibrate

New hardware should not be provided to the labs until the panel decides on a plan for coordinated references

No need to adjust reference periods right now due to lack of demand.

Marnix/Mark Cooper will work to determine how many kits of old hardware they need. Marnix will then calibrate on old hardware. If any other labs

Is it time to work on the new LTMS for the ISM?

Also the new reference oil blend will require coordinated references so there will be potential for back to back coordinated reference runs.

Jim McCord brought up the TGC's desire for feedback from this panel to the boilerplate wording to be added to all procedures for new suppliers.
