SUBJECT: ISB Calibration Period Change

On August 28, 2012, via teleconference, the Cummins Test Surveillance panel unanimously approved reducing the calibration period for ISB test stands from 18 months to 12 months. This change is effective with any calibration period established on or after August 29th, 2012. Section 9.3 of D7484 has been revised and is attached.

- 9.3 Stand Calibration Period:
- 9.3.1 A test stand calibration test is carried out 12 months or 12 operationally valid non-reference oil tests, whichever comes first, following the completion of the last successful calibration test.

Delete current 9.3.2

9.3.2 *Last Start Date*—A non-reference oil test can be completed provided the warm-up is started prior to the expiration of the calibration period.
