Infineum comments

Given recent performance in the T-12 with candidate oils, it appears that the round of reference testing on the U batch of liners did not give us sufficient data to adequately define the severity of the U batch liners, and we suspect they may be showing high variability. Infineum anticipates that collecting a round of reference oil data on the V batch of liners probably won't be any more help in defining severity. However, Infineum is concerned about setting a precedent by bringing in new hardware without generating reference oil data.

Oronite comments

Oronite is concerned about setting a precedent of bringing in new hardware without generating reference oil data to develop correction factors, etc. Recent performance of candidate data using U batch liners shows higher variability than the original performance of the test on the reference oil (prior to 2006 through the end of 2008). Original performance of the test (prior to 2006 through the end of 2008) is the target for oil consumption, Pb, Pb2, liner wear and ring wear.
