As a result of a July 27, 2010 conference call, the Sequence III Surveillance Panel approved a motion to delete the requirement to conduct a reference oil test every 90 days in laboratories which have more than one stand. Section 10.3.2 has been deleted.

The attached change to Test Method D 6984 is effective July 27, 2010.
