TO: Sequence IV Surveillance Panel

SUBJECT: Oil Consumption Limit

Recently it was noted that an oil consumption limit was not included in Test Method D8350. A limit of a maximum of 1000 g of end of test oil consumption was approved by the Sequence IV Surveillance panel during the September 26, 2018 Surveillance Panel conference call, but was never incorporated into the draft procedure or subsequent test method. New section 11.16.3.2 has been added to require invalidation of tests where end of test oil consumption exceeds 1000g.

The attached new section of Test Method D8350 is effective September 26, 2018.
