1.) **Roll Call** – Attachment #1 shows members and guests present.

2.) **Discussion: Introduction of reblend 538-1** – The following motion was made by Dwight Bowden and seconded by Ed Altman:

All calibrated labs (as-of 07/17/07) are required to donate "1" test on 538-1, in return the lab would get a 1 test (150hrs 0r 7 day) extension to the reference period for the stand/engine used in the donated run. These tests should be completed by August 15, 2007.

The vote was: Approved 8 Disapproved 0 Waive 1

Discussion:

Labs that are not calibrated as-of 07/17/07 will run their donated test once they receive calibration status.

Rich will send corrected Calibration Confirmations once a valid test is completed; he also mentioned he would start the process to ship this oil to all labs.

Once we have 5 donated tests TMC will review the data and send their summary and comments to the Chairman, the Seq. VIB SP will need to approve the introduction.

3.) **Discussion: Oil circulation pump bypass** – Lubrizol requested the SP consider allowing the use of a by-pass pump due to safety concerns. During the discussion SP members stated concerns with allowing this change and also determined the possibility of a "dead head" in this circuit is unlikely. The SP requested that Lubrizol pass this discussion from the SP members along to their Safety Committee. It was agreed that this discussion will tabled until Lubrizol has a chance to do this and if there is still a concern the SP will hold additional discussions on this issue. Lubrizol should contact the Chairman if further action is required.

4.) **New Business** –

a. Charlie mentioned he had just received a question from AER concerning the "Engine Balance", the question was:

The 4.6L has gone to a "new balance" setup. I'm trying to see if we can find a supplier for the old balance. Would there be a problem using the new balance setup?

Charlie stated he needs to talk with Ron Romano at Ford before sending a response to AER.

b. Bill Busher mentioned that some of the Surveillance Panels may meet in the late September time frame this year due no SP meetings were held earlier this year. Rich stated he could not be available the last week of September due to prior commitments. The Chairman stated once the date was selected for the meeting he would notify the VIB SP members to determine if a face-to-face meeting was needed, he commented it is hard to justify this type of meeting if it is not required.
