- 3.5 GM to report to the SP what the last date of purchase for 2012 LY7 engines at the next SP meeting. The last date is 04.01.2012, so a decision should be made by end of February. There will be another PFI 3.6, but for a different platform.
- 3.6 Rich Grundza will ask the reference oil suppliers whether they would allow the oil analysis tests mentioned above to be run on their reference oils. He is still awaiting a response.

5.1 Review outcome of the first two tests on RO-542 and determine if we should run additional reference oils. Gordon says they are mild for FEI1. Guy Stubbs had done a by-stage review, and 1, 2 and 3 had the most effect as expected. There was a high BLA and oil pressure was higher on both engines. This engine has a different pressure relief valve. Guy's data indicated the engine response was dropping faster that the D versions, so there was interest in more data to confirm if this trend continues. It may then be feasible to adjust the engine hour equation for the 2012 engines.

Motion: Move forward with the next new engine reference oil [541, 10w-30] at SwRI and IAR, then have further discussion at another conference call.

Motion: Modify Section 11.5.2 of D7589 as follows.

11.5.2 Oil Charge for Break-in Service both oil filters to ensure that they are clean. Drain oil and charge the engine with fresh BL oil, adding 5.4L. Use this oil charge for the entire new engine break-in.

11.5.2.1 Oil Additions During Break-in Monitor oil pan level on an hourly basis, during Step A operation. When oil pan level reaches **400 [this was changed during motion discussion as two labs already use this volume]** ml below test full, add fresh BL oil to bring it back to the original test full level using the same batch used for initial break-in oil charge. Record oil additions and break-in hour addition was completed.
