The meeting was called to order at 9:08 AM Central Time by Chair Andrew Stevens.

- 2.0 Roll Call. Attendance is Attachment 2. There were no member changes.
- 3.0 Old Business

MOTION: Approve minutes from the 09.08.2020 conference call.
Andrew, Ben second. Approval was unanimous.

4.0 New Business

4.1 This meeting was focused on a request to add D5800 to the test reports. This had started as an E-ballot, but had comments so the item was moved to a conference call.

4.1.1 There were question on whether it would be all tests, or just on request. D5800 is part of test registration and is usually run but only reported to the requestor. There were questions on new versus used oil, but the intent was to run on new oil.

4.1.2 A few suggestions were made such as adding a box on registration, but this would change ACC registration method. Final discussion was to add to the comments page on the test report if the formulator requested the data. The motion was withdrawn.

4.2 Rich added a discussion item that reference oil 1011 was now a re-blend.

4.2.1 This would not be needed until 2021 as testing is light. Travis recommended not using only first runs on the engine.

4.2.2 As part of the review process it was recommended that more chemical tests be run for the current versus new blend, including NOACK, and CCS or MRV to capture cold response.

4.2.3 The test currently does not verify the viscosity of the oil. There was concern this should be added.

4.3 The TGC Fuels Task Force has met and the VIE specifications has been be updated. There will then be further work on the alternate fuel supplier criteria. See Attachment 3.

The meeting adjourned at 1:56 PM.
