SUBJECT: Requirement for Changing Fuel Batches

During the January 16, 2020 Sequence VI Surveillance Panel Conference call, the panel agreed to add a requirement to add a new fuel batch only when the laboratory's fuel tank is below 10 % of the final fuel. As a result, section 7.2.3 has been added to define the new requirement.

After the new fuel batch is added, the resulting volume of fuel is to consist of no more than 10 % of the current batch and at least 90 % of the new batch.
