SUBJECT: Severity Adjustment Standard Deviation

On February 5, 2001, the Sequence VIII Surveillance Panel approved an electronic ballot to revise the standard deviation used for the calculation of severity adjustments in the Sequence VIII test. The previous standard deviation for the severity adjustment calculation was 5.28, based 10 data points from reference oil 1006. The new standard deviation is 4.80, based on 30 data points on reference oil 1006. This standard deviation should be used for calculation of severity adjustments on all reference oil tests completed on or after February 6, 2002.
