## Background

Stand is currently referenced as of May 2018. Current LTMS procedure lists that the stand can only be out of reference for one reference period before having to declare a new stand. To bring on a new stand, a total of 5 reference tests must be run before a candidate test is completed. The current industry demand can't sustain stand referencing.

## **New Stand Requirements**

TMC has developed wording to include in the ASTM D5579 test procedure. The wording includes two new statements that define what will be declared a new test lab and a new test stand. Stand will still be referenced for 6 months. Candidate will still be compared to previous 5 reference tests.

Members voted on the addition of the two statements to the test procedure. All members in attendance approved. No members voted against. TMC will send out an information letter regarding additional statements to test procedure.
