**1.0 Summary of Meeting Discussions**

**1.1 Rating Distress Photos**

ASTM will be taking over ownership of the former CRC Manual 21. There was a need to reprint the photos for the new books that ASTM will distribute. Initially, the photos appeared quite different when compared to the originals. After several iterations, the rating photos have been updated. All labs passed along that their raters were happy with the photos and don't feel they will effect severity of the test.

**Motion # 1** → Mr. Lind - Motion to approve the new L-37 rating distress photos. The effective date will be 30 days after the photos are available from ASTM. The TMC will inform the labs when the photos are available and specify the effective date. All labs will have to use new photos from this effective date. Section 12.2.1 of the procedure will be updated to reflect this. 2<sup>nd</sup> – Dale. The motion passed with a vote of – Yes-7, No-0, Abstentions-1

Mr. Lind also mentioned that ASTM is working to change the name of the former CRC Manual 21. Once this name is decided the L-37 procedure will be updated to reflect the new name of the manual. There will also be a reference to the old name.
