12.4 For a test rating to be valid, the gears shall be rated by an individual who has participated in an ASTM gear-rater calibration workshop within the previous twelve months and has been calibrated as outlined in the L-37 Rater Calibration Monitoring System (RCMS). The RCMS calibration period is every 6 months or as otherwise required by the RCMS.
