During its May 13, 2015 meeting, the L-37 Surveillance Panel approved the addition of wording clarifying when a non-reference may be considered to have been run on a calibrated test stand.

Section 9.1 of D 6121 has been updated. The text of the revision is shown in the attachment. This change is effective immediately.

(Revises Test Method D 6121-15 as modified by Information Letter 15-1)

Replace the current wording of section 9.1 with the following:

9.1 Reference Test Frequency – The test stand calibration period is defined as four months or 650 test hours, whichever occurs first. It begins on the completion date of an operationally and statistically acceptable reference oil test as determined by the TMC. Any test started on or before the stand calibration expiration date is defined to have been run on a calibrated stand.
