SUBJECT: L-37-1 Reference Oil 134/134-1 LTMS Requirements

During a January 29th, 2020 Surveillance Panel conference call the panel members agreed to apply the additional requirement for 134/134-1 reference oil tests, that was applied to lubricated hardware with TMC memo 19-040, to non-lubricated hardware reference tests as well. The requirement is that the test must fail the GL-5 requirements for at least one of the four critical parameters in order to be a passing reference test. This is in addition to also meeting the targets established in the LTMS system. This additional requirement only applies to 134/134-1 reference oil. The effective date of this change is February 12th, 2020.
