# 1.0 Update & Discussion

- C. Prengaman shared the ratings from the gears that were sent around to the labs. These gears are a selection of the initial runs from Afton. T. Gottwald shared that he will send a few more for additional review.
- C. Prengaman shared that an updated draft procedure was sent to the smaller working group and requested comments as time allows.
