### L42 Matrix

Action Item: TMC to assign lab matrix oils, should receive Wed Feb 25<sup>th</sup>.

#### Lab visits/SP action item: TMC got Questions relative to ramp down at each lab

Each lab summarized their procedure after conditioning 4/shock1

- Afton's: Accelerate after shock 1 or conditioning 4 to bring torque to drive side, ramp down engine (1.5-2minutes), but keep torque on axles. Shift to neutral, and brake dyno's to bring axles to zero speed. Total Test time 68-70minutes
- SWRI: ramp down relatively quickly after cond and shock 1, but keep load on drive side of gears (not on coast side). Shift to neutral and acknowledge, brake dyno's to bring to zero speed. Total test time 65 minutes
- LZ: Accelerate engine, then shift to neutral and then allows axle to coast down on its own. Inspections are typically 7minutes. Test time 70-75 minutes
- Parc: (Ralph) Total test time 68-70 minutes, they do not use load once transmission is shifted to neutral, but let dyno's coast. Inspection is approximately 5 minutes.

TMC has not seen test length invalidate a test.

Agreement was labs do not see an issue.
