SUBJECT: Re-wording of mid-test inspection requirements

The L-42 Surveillance Panel voted to change the wording associated with the mid-test inspections 1 and 2 in the L-42 test method. A test lab expressed safety concerns with conducting the mid-test inspections on a running test stand. Because of this the panel agreed to add wording into the test procedure stating that the inspection is highly recommended. If a test lab chooses not to complete the inspections, then the table on Form 4 of the report packet should be left blank. This change is effective immediately.

Replace the text in sections 10.2.5 & 10.4 with the following:

10.2.5 *Inspection 1*—(Warning—Differential is extremely hot. Hot oil can produce vapors.) Inspection 1 is highly recommended but not required to meet the validity requirements of the test.

10.4 *Inspection 2*—(Warning—Differential is extremely hot. Hot oil can produce vapors.) Inspection 2 is highly recommended but not required to meet the validity requirements of the test.
