Report of Meeting L-60-1 SP Meeting PRI Headquarters, Apollo Room, Warrendale, Pa. November 3rd, 2004

<u>Sign-in/Review of Membership</u>: The meeting was called to order at 08:50 am. A review of the agenda was completed and is included as *Attachment 1*. The sign-in sheet is *Attachment 2*. There were no membership changes to report.

Approval of August Surveillance Panel Meeting Minutes:

The meeting minutes from the August 25, 2004 are on the TMC website which can be found from the following path (ftp://ftp.astmtmc.cmu.edu/docs/gear/I601/minutes/). The Chairman sent out a notice to the L-60-1 Surveillance Panel (SP) prior to the November meeting to notify them that the minutes were available. The minutes are in a public folder that is available to anyone. Anyone having problems accessing an electronic copy of the minutes should contact Mr. Frank Farber from the TMC for help.

Mr. Don Lind had one point of clarification from the August L-60-1 minutes. As Motion 1 was stated in the minutes, "...Labs can continue using extra insulation when they feel it is necessary and can use full enclosures or insulation..." Mr. Lind asked for the panel's interpretation on whether the use of extra insulation around the test rig was covered in the prior sentence. After some discussion, the panel members agreed that this sentence covered the use of extra insulation as an enclosure around the test rig.

Motion 1 (Motion \Rightarrow Brian Koehler Second \Rightarrow Cory Koglin) To approve the August 25, 2004 minutes with the one change by inserting the following corrected sentence..."...Labs can continue using extra insulation when they feel it is necessary and the use of extra insulation as an enclosure around the test rig..."

Motion Results: Approved

In favor: 6 Opposed: 0 Abstain: 0

Action Item: Chris Schenkenberger to make the correction and submit the minutes to be posted on the TMC website.

Summary of Meeting Discussions

Test Stand Drawings:

As of the August 25^{th} SP meeting, all 19 revised drawings were approved with an implementation date of 1/01/05. The L-60 Task Force had identified one additional issue that needed to be addressed before the new drawings go into effect. The Chairman acknowledged that Koehler produced test rigs have an issue with the heater case cover (drawing # D-6-6376-41A-Z). While the over-all width, length, and height of the heater case cover was okay, the flanged mounting had some minor differences from the print. The L-60 Task Force felt that this difference would not have an effect on test severity and the discrepancy should be addressed in a note on the heater case cover drawing. In order to insure that all rigs can comply with the drawing requirements

being implemented January 1, 2005, the following recommendation from the L-60 Task Force was presented as a motion to the L-60-1 Surveillance Panel.

Motion 2 (Motion⇒ Brian Koehler Second⇒ Cory Koglin)

Add a note to drawing D-6-6376-41A-Z saying that "Flanged mounting surface of the oven cover assembly can be modified for proper sealing, provided the inner dimensions of the box are maintained according to the print. An arrow will be drawn on the schematic to indicate the precise area being addressed".

Motion Results: Approved

In favor: 4 Opposed: 0 Abstain: 1

Action Item: The Chairman will email the motion to Mr. Koglin and Mr. Koehler. Mr. Koehler will work with the appropriate department at SwRI to complete the L-60-1 Surveillance Panel request of adding this note to the heater case cover drawing.

New Business

The Chairman indicated that after the Gear Rating Workshop, which is to be held at Ethyl in January of 2005, he would work with the TMC to bring the data for the surveillance panel to review at the next meeting. The TMC has observed a shift (mild) in average carbon varnish of the magnitude of 0.5 to 1.5 standard deviations at two labs during 2004. A third lab has exhibited no change. TMC wants to confirm if this shift is a result of a laboratory or rating issue. In an effort to find the cause, Mr. Lind has assigned TMC 151-3 more frequently at the labs for stand qualification attempts. He will be working with each test laboratory to bring some of these gears to the rating workshop for review.

In discussing the approximate date for the shift in severity, Surveillance Panel members asked that the TMC take hardware into consideration. As another possible cause, the SP asked Mr. Lind to check gear set identification numbers (11-00-XX) to see if there had been a change at that time. The gear set identification numbers were stamped into each L-60-1 gear set made from the November 2000 industry hardware batch. The numbers identified from which bar of steel the gear was made from.

Action Item: Chairman to bring L-60-1 data from January Rater Workshop.

Action Item: Mr. Lind to look at the serialized bar codes for reference tests at the time of the observed shift.

(Motion to adjourn \Rightarrow Don Bartlett, Second \Rightarrow Juan Buitrago) The meeting was adjourned at 9:22 am.
