Approval of meeting minutes

Chairman called for a vote to accept the February 18 and May 13, 2015 Surveillance Panel Meeting Minutes. Motion by M. Umerley to accept the minutes as submitted, 2nd by J. Dharte. Approved 8-0-0

Discussion of L-60-1 Severity and proposed Correction factors continued from the May meeting

S. Parke (TMC) presented date on Transformed vs Non-transformed (the following are highlights)

Transformed units are used for statistical analysis based on data with a normal distribution. This can add a level of confusion to our work. Should we remove transformation and apply correction factor? Parke present Control charts with and without transformation applied. It showed we lose standard deviation when we untransform current control chart numbers. Scott used a different method for his plots ("pooled S" method).

Scott then showed Control chart with correction applied.

- October '98 > today gets correction applied (Oct '98 shows a visible severity shift on control chart)
- 151-2 gets a 0.6 added to ACV merit scale
- 148 is unchanged because targets were set before the Oct '98 shift
- Downtick in past 6 months Intertek and SwRI running mostly RO 148
- Reference FAILS 87/670 to 95/670 (looking at all parameters)
- Original Unit Targets
- L. Hamilton called for a motion based on S. Parke presentation.
- R. Warden requested a postponement of a motion to give everyone time to look over the new data from S. Parke. All were in agreement.
- L. Hamilton proposes that we have a motion worded based on:
 - Remove the transformation from the test on all parameters
 - Adopt Scotts proposed targets
 - Back transform the targets for all oils that predated '98 severity shift
 - Use a "pooled-S" that includes only these oils predating '98
 - Adopt 0.6 ACV Correction Factor
 - 151-2 new targets will be derived from data using the 0.6 correction factor for ACV
 - In future reporting, the derived 0.6 correction will be applied to all data that is reported
 - Argent to submit new motion wording
 - Remove transformation
 - New targets for 151-2
 - 0.6 Correction Factor

The proposed motion was:

- 1. Remove the transformation from all test parameters
- 2. Adopt targets presented by TMC during the 8-12-2015 meeting (see attached)
- 3. Add 0.6 to ACV for all tests after 10/01/2015

Chairman will follow up with a Conference call or E Ballot. ; see attachment #3
